

Genetic change over time





ALC Brahmans leads the way, as per the 2023 Bush Agribusiness 'Top Studs' report www.bushagri.com.au, with the highest Central Production \$ Index and Live Export \$ Index figures of all the 20 studs that met the 'Top Studs' criteria for Brahmans.

ALC Brahmans has extremely high EBV accuracy and consistency due to the substantial amount of phenotypic/raw data submitted and analyzed over the whole herd (in large numbers) on a yearly basis, for many generations. From our observations, Genomic EBVs generated from a DNA sample only, with no accompanying raw measurements, leads to regular and substantial EBV movement and is not good practice.

In the past decade, ALC has doubled its numbers of stud cattle, whilst maintaining a high standard of conformation, muscling, and temperament. During this time, we have almost halved the joining period on all breeders, both stud and commercial. ALC breeders must wean a live calf every year and conceive whilst lactating, to retain a spot in the herd. ALC Breeders wean a 7 to 8-month-old calf every year regardless of the season and are joined

from 1st October every year regardless of the season, thus finding the genetics that truly earn their place in the herd.
